This guide outlines the consultations, investigations, and treatments offered at the Women's Health Hub. Care is provided by senior clinicians with specialist expertise in women's health, fertility, and early pregnancy.

We are recognised by most major health insurance providers. Patients are asked to settle consultation fees directly and reclaim costs from their insurer. If documentation is required to support an insurance claim, we are happy to provide this.

## CONSULTATIONS

<b>Consultation</b> - A comprehensive consultation focused on understanding your symptoms, concerns, and priorities, with a clear assessment, management plan, and follow-up advice.	£150
<b>Consultation with Point-of-Care Ultrasound</b> - Includes a comprehensive consultation plus an in-clinic ultrasound where clinically appropriate.	£200
<b>Follow-up consultation</b> - A review appointment suitable for established patients with ongoing or long-term conditions. This consultation is intended for reviewing progress, results, or management plans previously agreed and is not suitable for new problems.	£80



## GYNAECOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS & TREATMENT

These investigations are typically arranged following an initial consultation, where your clinician may advise that further testing would be helpful to guide diagnosis or management.

<b>Endometriosis Saliva Test (Endo Test)</b> – A saliva-based test sent to a London laboratory to assess the likelihood of endometriosis. Price includes follow up with explanation of results.	£1,000
<b>Endometrial Biopsy</b> – May be recommended in the assessment of abnormal or unexplained vaginal bleeding, this is performed within a consultation and the fee will be added to the consultation charge.	£50

## CONTRACEPTION SERVICES

We recognise that contraception fitting can be associated with anxiety, often related to fear of pain or previous experiences. Patient comfort and reassurance are central to our approach. Where appropriate, we offer ultrasound guidance during fittings and endeavour to provide “Penthrox – gas and air” pain relief. We recommend bringing someone with you if you plan to use gas and air.

## FERTILITY INVESTIGATIONS & TREATMENT

<p><b>Female Fertility MOT</b> – A structured fertility assessment including cycle-specific hormone monitoring and private AMH testing analysed at a London laboratory. The package consists of three appointments across one menstrual cycle, including early-cycle blood tests (days 2–5), a mid-cycle consultation and scan, and late-cycle hormone testing (usually day 21). A written report of your results will be provided.</p> <p>If cycles are irregular, the structure of the Female Fertility MOT will be individualised and agreed with your clinician.</p>	£350
<p><b>Male Fertility MOT</b> – Consultation, blood tests, and organisation of semen analysis. A written report of your results will be provided.</p>	£150
<p><b>Ovulation Induction</b> – Includes all consultations and blood tests required throughout one month’s treatment cycle.</p>	£200
<p><b>HyFoSy – Fallopian Tube Patency Testing</b> – Ultrasound-based tubal assessment with “Pentrox – gas and air” available for comfort. This test is typically arranged following an initial consultation, where your clinician can advise whether further investigation is required.</p>	£500

## EARLY PREGNANCY CARE

<p><b>Early Pregnancy Scan between 7-12 weeks</b> – Assessment or reassurance scan with discussion of findings.</p>	£150
<p><b>NIPT and Early Pregnancy Scan</b> – Combined non-invasive prenatal testing (NIPT) for Down syndrome, Edwards syndrome, Patau syndrome, and fetal sex can be performed from 10 weeks’ gestation.</p> <p>If you attend before 12 weeks, an early pregnancy scan will also be carried out. A written report of results is provided.</p>	£525

## IVF TREATMENT

IVF treatment is available through our partner fertility clinics, including Lister Fertility Clinic and Bristol Fertility Clinic. We are unable to offer government-funded IVF through the Jersey healthcare system; however, we can support non-funded IVF pathways and provide second opinions.

Pricing is discussed at the start of treatment cycles and is typically aligned with the fertility clinic involved. No additional charges are applied by the Women's Health Hub for treatment cycles, and costs are usually billed directly through the partner fertility clinic. Extra charges may apply to follow up consultations outside of the treatment cycles.

## ADVANCED ENDOMETRIAL TESTING

We can organise additional investigations where clinically appropriate, including EMMA / ALICE / ERA endometrial testing.

## SEMEN DNA FRAGMENTATION TESTING

This test can be arranged where clinically indicated through a specialist London laboratory. The relevance, suitability, and pricing of these investigations may be discussed on an individual basis.
